About Saj

Saj Hussain, our hardworking and popular Borough and County Councillor is standing again and seeking another four-year term to continue serving the residents of Knaphill and Goldsworth West.

Saj has been the sub-postmaster at Knaphill Post Office for the last 31 years. He is an active member of the Royal British Legion, a governor of both Hermitage School and the North West Surrey Short Stay School in Woking, and a supporter of both the Knaphill Residents' Association and Goldsworth Park Community Association.

Saj has worked tirelessly to improve resurfacing and repairs to local roads, including the Amstal Way roundabout on Lockfield Drive which was continuously flooded and which issue thanks to Saj is now resolved. Working with local residents, Saj campaigned for and secured a safer crossing island for nursery children on Littlewick Road.

Anti-social parking around schools is a borough wide issue, but Saj has managed to secure a disused tennis court in Sussex Park for school drop off and pick up to ease pressure on local traffic congestion at these peak hours.

Recognising the lack of youth facilities in

the area, Saj worked to secure new premises which will see The Cabin youth club move to the Woking Youth Arts Centre in Trinity Road.

Using his councillor allocation funding, Saj is pleased that he has been able to help fund repairs to the roof of the swimming pool at St. John's Primary School, provide new maps around Goldsworth Park, new kitchen equipment at Goldwater Lodge, and numerous other benefits including the hanging flower baskets in Knaphill High Street last year.

There is still much to do in the division and, with your support on 4th May, Saj hopes to be able to continue this work for the next four years.

Local remembrance garden opens

Last year's Remembrance Day, 11 November 2016, was a very proud day for Saj. Local residents gathered in the centre of Knaphill to remember the heroes who laid down their lives in conflict to make the world a better place for all of us.

An active member of the Royal British Legion, it was Saj's vision and determination to create a

Remembrance Garden in Knaphill High Street as a fitting and everlasting memorial which can serve as a focus point for Armistice and Remembrance Day services in future years. Saj said: "I am very grateful to all the Knaphill Churches and schools who came together to help with the service in November. I hope they will continue to do so on those days in future years."
