The services that Lakers provided to local residents are being continued from other sites, although clearly the way that they are delivered has had to be changed.

Conservative Woking Borough Councillor **Chitra Rana** wants to see Lakers re-open as soon as possible and has called on Surrey County Council to commit to re-opening the site as well as maintaining its current services on other sites for the time being.

Chitra said: "I think we have to see that building fully functioning again for the sake of all the residents who use it.

"Conservative Councillors are pledging to help in any way they can with the work that needs to be done to make that happen.

"We cannot allow one event to undo all the good work done at Lakers."

GREEN SPACE SAVED FROM DEVELOPMENT

Conservatives in Goldsworth Park have saved a significant patch of green space from a proposed development.

The land, in Jasmine
Close, is owned by Woking
Borough Council and was
going to be sold off for
housing. But intervention
from Conservative
Councillors including Saj
Hussain and Chitra Rana
meant that the Council

decided to re-think their plans for the site.

Chitra said: "I am really pleased that we have got the results residents wanted in Jasmine Close, despite the Lib Dems trying to get the development idea voted through.

"Residents were quite clear about what they wanted and Conservatives have listened."



CHITRA CAMPAIGNING FOR BETTER PLAY FACILITIES

■ Play facilities off Oakfield are way below the standard of facilities elsewhere in Woking. Although the Council has installed some recycling bins, the play equipment needs updating and we need to make the space more fun for children and young people to use.

"Residents around here and their children deserve better," said **Chitra**. "I have spoken to a number of people who would like to see this play area brought up to the standard of Knaphill and St John's nearby.

"I'm fighting hard for those improvements and will report back when I have more news."
