Matt Hancock was born in Cheshire and studied at Exeter and Christ's College. He was an economist at the Bank of England before serving as a senior economic advisor and then later Chief of Staff to George Osborne. From 2013 he served under both David Cameron and Theresa May and was promoted to the Cabinet in the January 2018 cabinet reshuffle when he was appointed Culture Secretary. In July 2018 he became Health and Social Care Secretary. In May 2019 he announced his intention to stand in the Conservative Party leadership election but withdrew from the race in June. After endorsing Boris Johnson he was retained in his cabinet.
